


# Programming-jam 6.0

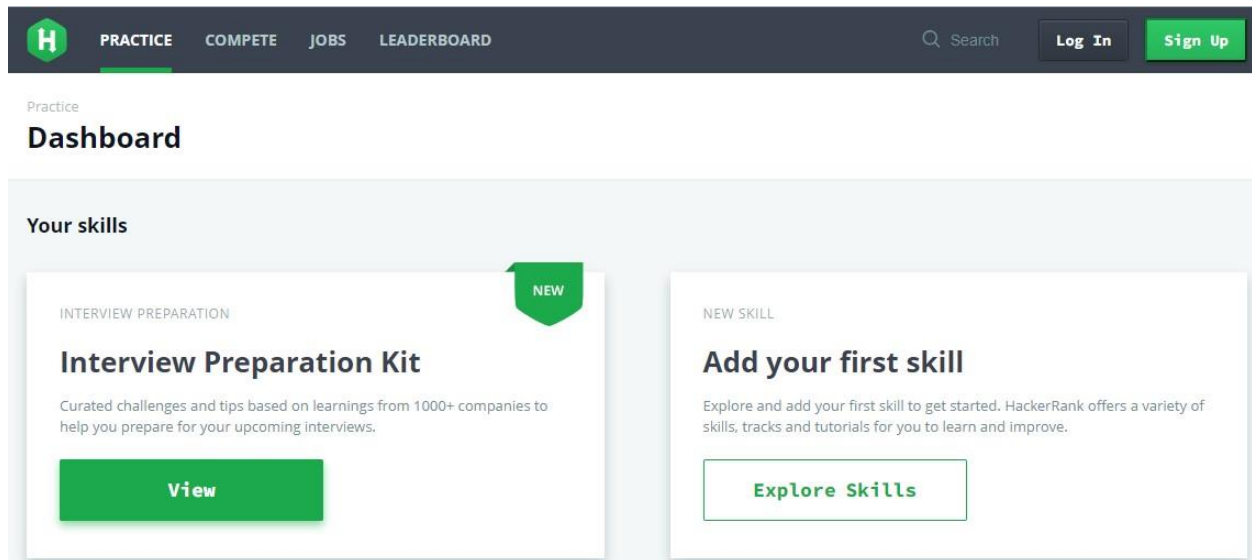

## Step 1. Register at hackerrank

Go to [www.hackerrank.com](http://www.hackerrank.com)

Signup and create an account. You need to provide an email address that can be used to verify your account.

Once you have created your account, you need to remember your user handle. This is needed to create teams.



## Step 4. Edit team details
